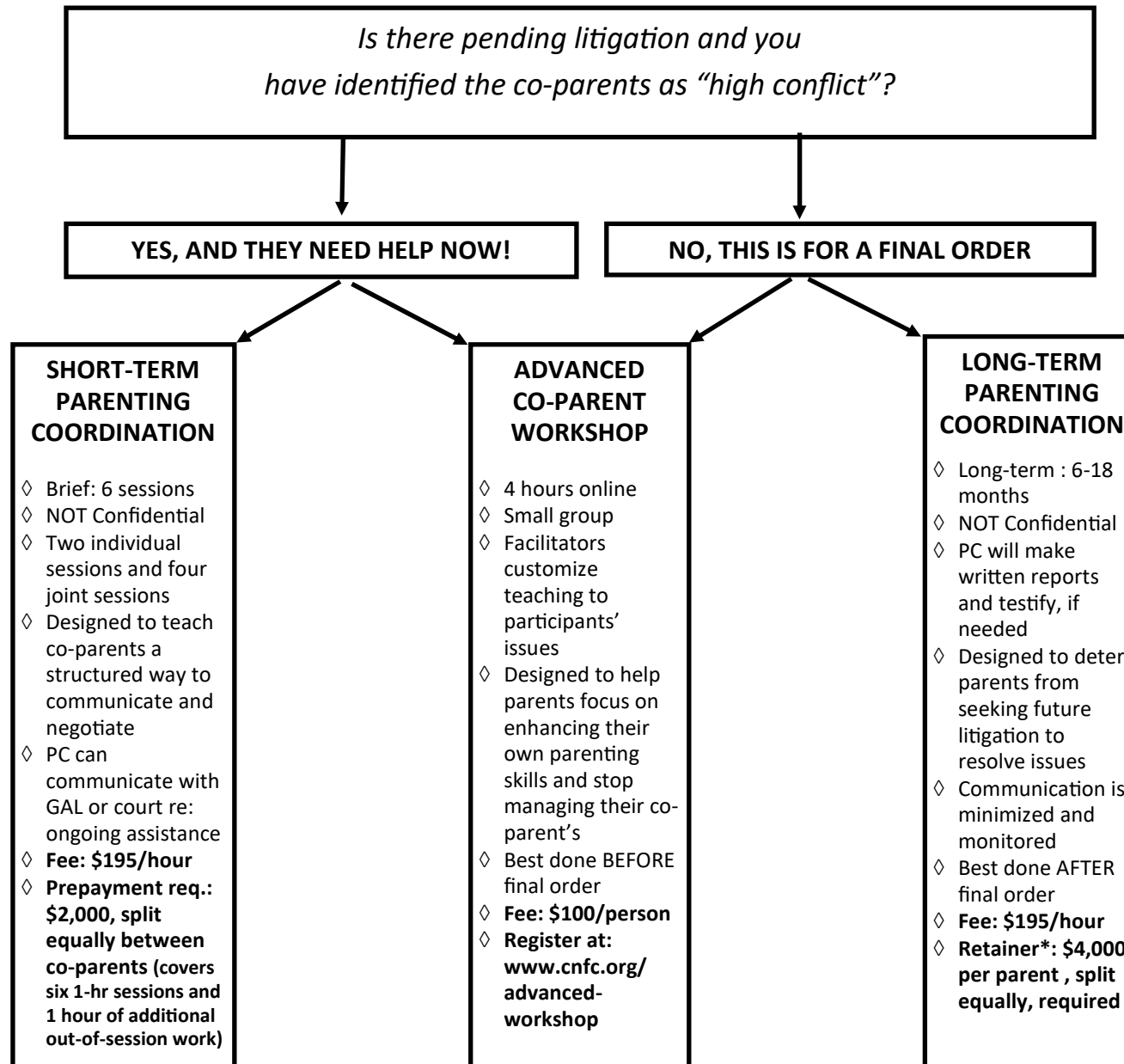

# CO-PARENTING SERVICES DECISION TREE

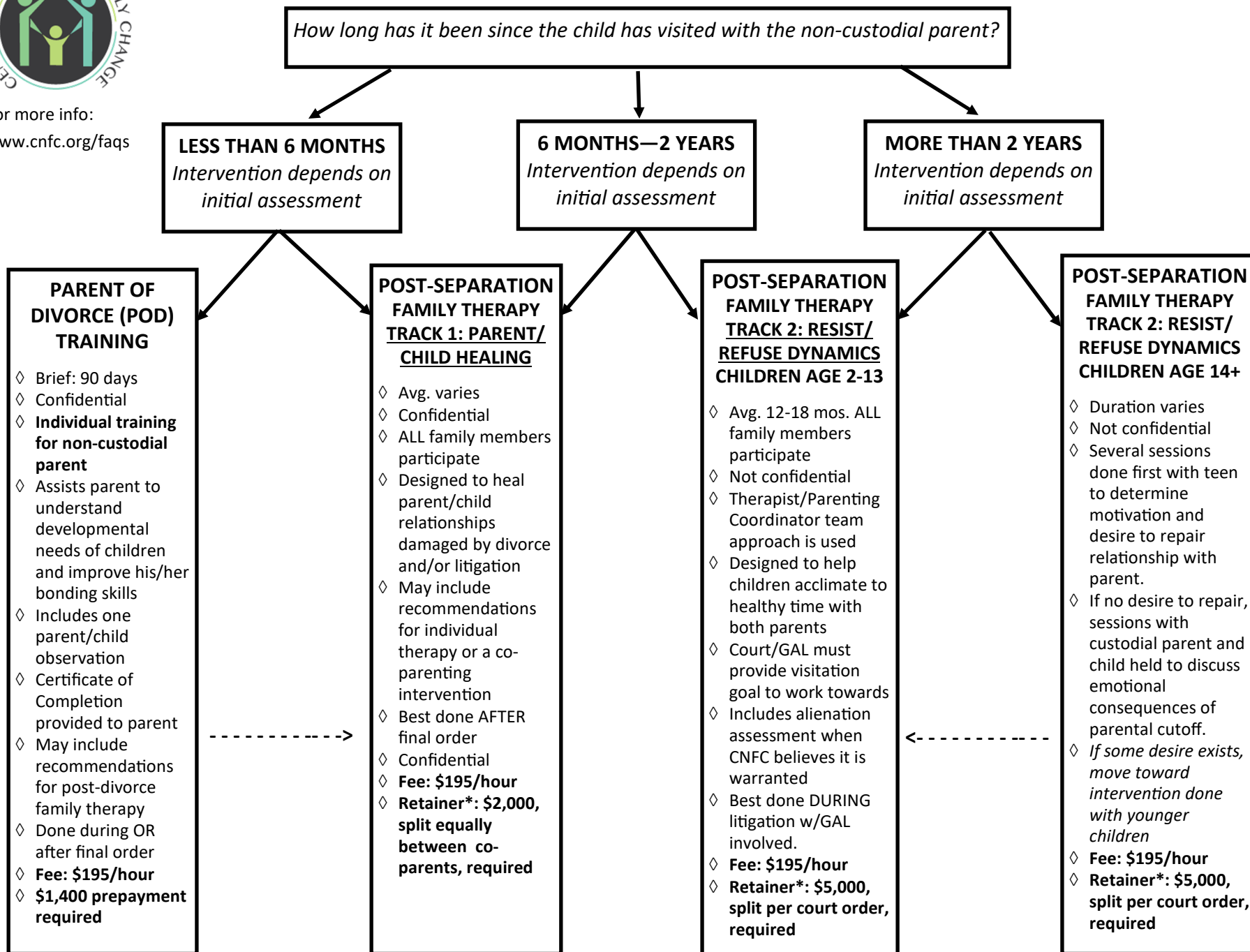


*\*Retainer is meant to provide for 10-20 hours of work. After it is depleted, parties will be expected to replenish.*

# BRIEF CONFLICT ASSESSMENT

*If the case is complex or you aren't sure what intervention to recommend, a brief **Conflict***

**Assessment** might be the best approach, especially if the case is still pending. CNFC will meet with you clients individually to talk to them about their concerns and goals. Then a recommendation will be made to the court or the attorneys regarding how we can best help their children and the co-parents after the case is over.

## BRIEF CONFLICT ASSESSMENT

- ◇ Brief: individual sessions with each parent and a session with the children
- ◇ Parents meet with separate therapists in the organization
- ◇ Therapists confer with Clinical Director about the case
- ◇ Clinical Director writes an assessment report that recommends interventions or mental health services
- ◇ Written assessment does NOT include any diagnoses or make recommendations for custody or parenting time
- ◇ Fee: \$195 per hour, with \$800 prepayment up front (\$400/parent) to cover three sessions, therapist conference, and written conflict assessment.
